



## SuperDuo Medallion Bracelet

Level of Difficulty: Novice



### Materials List:

- 11/0 seed beads
- 28 4mm Swarovski bicone crystals (can substitute a 4mm pearl or Czech glass bead)
- 28 SuperDuo beads - **Color A**
- 56 SuperDuo beads - **Color B**
- Pre-made Bracelet toggle
- 6 lb FireLine in Crystal or Smoke
- #10 or #12 Beading Needle
- Thread Conditioner or Beeswax (only if you are using Crystal FireLine, not necessary for Smoke FireLine)
- Thread Cutter
- Felt Beading Mat or Bead on It board

### **Instructions**

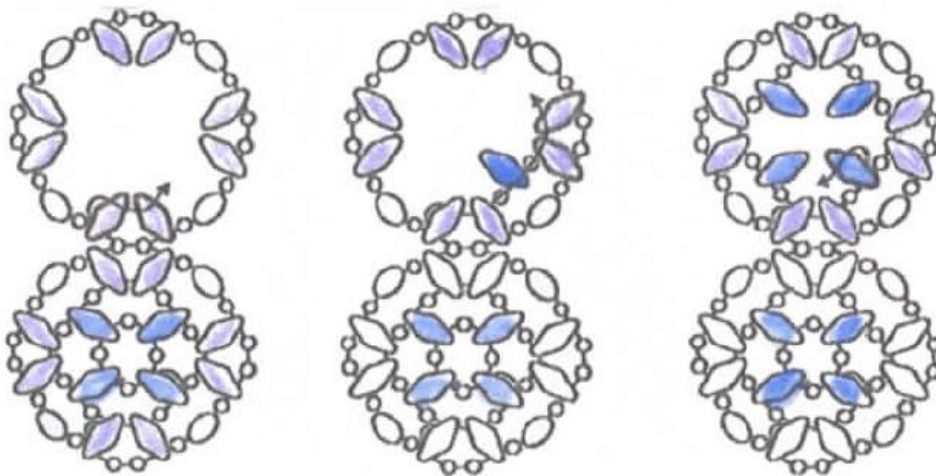
- This is a continuation of the SuperDuo Medallion Earring pattern from *The Essential Guide to Creating Epic Jewelry*. After completing Steps 1 – 4 from the SuperDuo Medallion Earring pattern, start with Step 5 below.
- For beginners, it is advised using a pre-made bracelet toggle. The toggle shown in the picture above was done using the peyote and circular peyote stitch for the more advanced beader.

- 5) Pick up (a SuperDuo **Color B**, a seed bead, a 4 mm bead, a seed bead, a SuperDuo **Color B**, 2 seed beads) 3 times then a SuperDuo **Color B**, a seed bead, a 4 mm

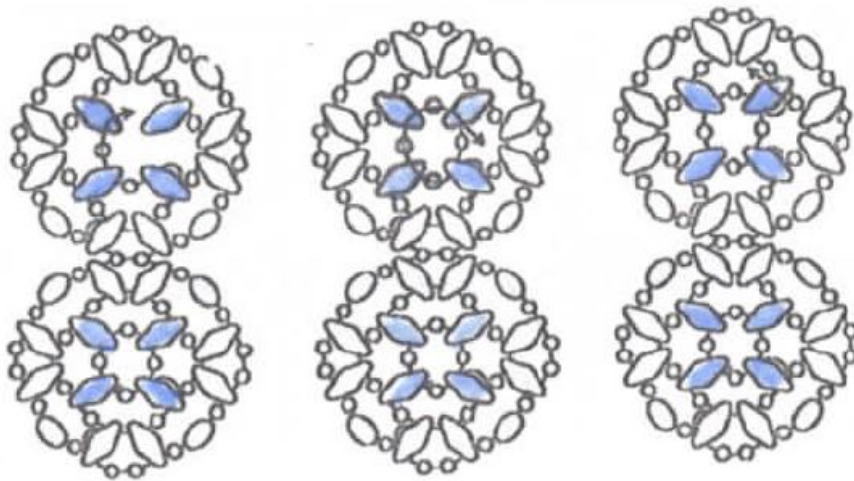
bead, a seed bead and a SuperDuo **Color B** and sew thru the 2 seed beads from your last medallion. Sew all around the ring to reinforce and thru the 2 seed beads from the previous medallion and the first SuperDuo **Color B**.



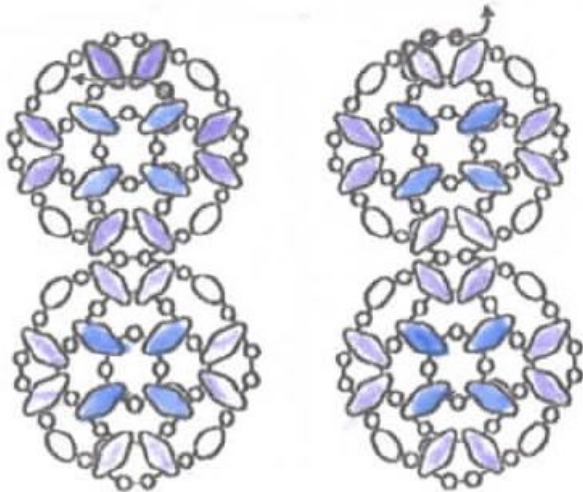
- 6) Sew thru the inside hole of the SuperDuo **Color B** and also the next one. Pick up a seed bead, a SuperDuo **Color A** and a seed bead. Sew thru the next pair of SuperDuo **Color Bs**. Repeat all the way around the circle, then sew thru the next seed bead and SuperDuo **Color A**.



- 7) Sew thru the SuperDuo **Color A** inside hole. Pick up a seed bead and sew thru the next SuperDuo **Color A**. Sew all around adding a seed bead between each SuperDuo **Color A**. Sew all around again to secure, then around to the 3<sup>rd</sup> SuperDuo **Color A** and back in the opposite direction thru the outside hole.



- 8) Sew thru the seed bead and the SuperDuo **Color B** pair. Then sew back thru the outside hole of the 2<sup>nd</sup> SuperDuo **Color B**, and the 2 seed beads on the end of the bracelet that is forming.



- 9) Flip the bracelet over and repeat steps 7 thru 10 until your bracelet is 1" shorter than the finished size you need. Anchoring to the 2 seed beads on each end, attach your clasp by picking up 2 to 5 seed beads (depending on the thickness of your toggle), go thru the loop of your clasp, pick up the same number of seed beads and attach to the 2 seed beads. Reinforce and tie off.
